Great River (L. I.) CC making extensive improvements on its 18-hole course and enlarging its dining room . . . Also considering plans for new pool to be located on the club's private beach . . . W. C. Hostetler, formerly located in Reno, Nev., is now assisting Walter Rich, supt. at the Pasadena GC in St. Petersburg, Fla.

This year's National Open had the biggest gate in the 57 years of the championship . . . Even before the Sunday playoff it was well ahead of the previous record set by the 1954 Open at Baltusrol . . . USGA increased prize money to \$30,000 . . . First prize was \$7200 . . . Last 25 pros to play 36 holes each got \$240.

Ticket advance sale was \$100,000 . . . Open drew very well from Cleveland and Detroit and many cities and towns in Ohio, Indiana and Michigan . . . Ed Carter and his outfit did another good ad selling job on the program getting around \$103,000 gross into the program , . . No record but a nice fat sum to contribute against heavy expenses for an expertly conducted tournament . . . Rent of parking space paid by club was \$5000.

Also issued booklet of illustrated hole-by-hole description of the course . . . Don Wolfe, Blade sports editor, never was on a course until two years ago . . . His interviews with golfers were perfect jobs . . . He let the subjects do the talking . . . Tom Bolger, Times sports editor, batted masterly columns of Open gossip and details . . . Staffs of both papers, reporters and photographers, worked on the Open as though they covered this sort of thing every day.

As you might expect, Inverness with its experience of two previous National Opens and the Inverness Four-Ball, handled the big event as smoothly as the work possibly could be done . . . James J. Loudest squawk we heard was from fans complaining that after paying \$6 to get in Saturday they were expected to pay a quarter for a sheet showing pairings, players, players' caddies' numbers and starting time . . . Joe Mayo, retired supt. formerly at Inverness, Pebble Beach and Hawaiian courses, was in the gallery at Inverness . . . Joe was in charge of the Inverness course during the 1931 Open when Supt. W. J. Rockefeller suffered a breakdown.
