for more than a six-year period has interested members of other clubs in the district. Belle Meade has built three greens under the supervision of Charlie Danner. The topsoil consists of 60 per cent sand, 20 per cent loam soil, 15 per cent peat humus and 5 per cent Vermiculite by volume. It was mixed off site and placed on the gravel subbase to a depth of another foot. The loose soil was firmed underfoot and then the surface was modified, where necessary to provide perfect surface runoff. Congressional bent stolons were planted on all three greens.

Based on six years of experience with bent greens, Danner says they are more satisfactory than the greens of Bermuda for summer and rye grass in the winter.
