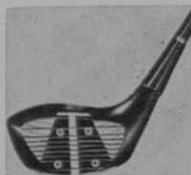

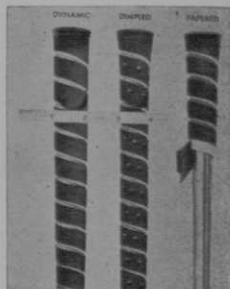

Grips are black prime calfskin with silver-grey center stripe and cork and rubber underlining. Woods and irons are matched and registered. Clubs are made by Walter Hagen Golf, Grand Rapids 2, Mich.

The grips fit woods or irons. The three styles are applied with tension for shock absorption. Flange-Wrap is made of suede-like rubber and resists moisture. The grip is made by CSI Sales Co., Solon, O., and sold through pro shops.
