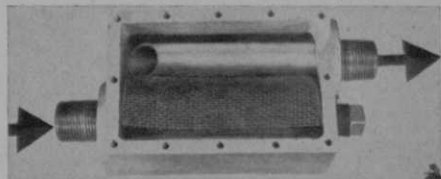

Flinchbaugh Three-Wheel Scooter Can Be Used by One or Two Players

Men-E-Uses golf scooter, made by the Flinchbaugh Co., 390 Eberts Lane, York, Pa., is a

lightweight, three wheel vehicle that can be used by one or two golfers. Bags can be carried in front of the steering column and a sulky seat may be added for the extra passenger. The scooter weighs only 177 lbs., is easy on turf and, according to the manufacturer,



is nicely balanced. It has a 4-cycle, 3 hp Briggs & Stratton gas engine and a 3-qt. tank provides enough fuel for seven hours of average running. An "accelebrake" controls the accelerator and brake through a single pedal. The scooter also has either single- or double-speed range that is selected by a shift lever. Goodyear super-rib tires of 10 lb. pressure and powerful front and rear coil springs are said to assure easy riding.

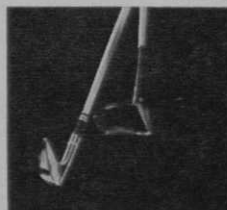
Don't Overlook Mary Lena
