Fourth Dorado Beach Invitational (for amateurs) scheduled for Dec. 6-9 in San Juan, P. R. . . . Western Hills CC, opened recently in Waterbury, Conn., brought city's total of municipal holes to 36 . . . Memorial GC, Springfield, Mass., designed by Geoffrey Cornish, to get its first test in spring of 1962 . . . Old Memorial course has been converted to an industrial park site . . . Morris County, N. J. (Morristown) to ask voters to approve \$2 million bond issue in November for development of course and further land acquisition.

Eighth All-American Intercollegiate tournament, sponsored by U. of Houston, to be played Mar. 28-31, 1962 . . . Last year it was attended by 4,000 persons and \$11,000 gate helped provide partial scholarships for 12 college students . . . Bakersfield, Calif., which is sponsoring its first \$25,000 Open Sept. 28-Oct. 1, calls attention to the fact that its population barely exceeds 100,000 . . .
