Action pictures of golfers are not interpreted easily, as good as the Graph-Check camera pictures are. They need the vertical line at the center of the head at address, and the horizontal lines at the knees, hips and shoulders so that changes of position are plainly seen. This is the method developed for the Golfing magazine sequence series after consultation with many teaching pros. 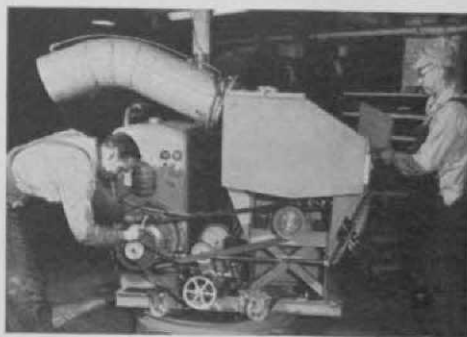
