

EOUIPMENT Continued from page 50 DuBose pointed out that the prices listed for the irrigation systems would be appreciably higher today. For his area he would list only two-a Manual at \$60,000 and Fully Automatic at \$100,-000. He did not think a Semi Automatic system would be suitable for use in Texas.

Ken Putnam, Supt. of Grounds, Seattle GC, Seattle, Washington commented that the list appeared to be quite complete for his area. He pointed out that the cost of some items seemed out of line. For instance, the vertical mower listed at \$700 would be purchased in his area for about \$200 (Ryan). He said that the automatic water system listed at \$70,000 would cost about \$85,000 now in his area. However, the last inventory figure taken at Seattle GC, Putnam said, showed a figure of \$55,000. So dollarwise, he considered, the list was still very much in line.

Ted Woehrle, supt., Beverly CC, Chicago, Illinois, commented on the 7-unit Hydraulic Tractor and Mowers in the Fairways and Roughs section on the list. He observed that you should never limit a tractor to one job and that you only need one 7 gang pull type and tractor. Woehrle suggested eliminating the 5-unit Fairway Gang Mower and adding one 7-unit Rough Gang Mower and one Ford LCG (\$2,500).

In the Tee and Greens section on the list, Woehrle considered that four Power Putting Green Mowers were enough. (The list shows six.) Under Miscellaneous General Equipment, he suggested reducing the number of Hand Broadcast Spreaders from three to two, and the number of Rotary Trimmer Mowers from five to two. He also suggested two Power Sprayers—one large, one small—not one as listed, and added two more items: 1 Power Sand Trap Rake (\$600) and 1 Trap Edger (\$200). Under Miscellaneous Items-Hand Equipment, Woehrle added 1 Shovel.

Charlie Danner, supt., Capital City CC, Atlanta, Georgia, made quite a few Continued on page 56

From the Fairways and Roughs Section, he eliminated the 3-Gang Fairway Roller; from Tee and Greens section, the Power Sickle Bar Trim; from Miscellaneous General Equipment section, the Proportioner w/nozzles and hose and the Water Ballast Roller.

Additions suggested by Danner were: Two more Power Putting Green Mowers; one more Power Vertical Mower; for the Rough, one 5 gang Blitzer Rough Mower (\$1,500) and one 90 inch Whirlwind Rotary PTO Mower (\$1,000); one Power Topdressing Screen (\$650); one Portable Electric Generator (\$350); one 1 Ton Power Roller (\$1140); two Fire Extinguishers (\$125); and one Power Rotavator (\$500).

As regards irrigation systems, Danner thought the Manual and Semi-Automatic were unsuitable, at least for his area. He saw as practical just the Portable Sprinklers and the Fully Automatic Systems. •




