

worked more organic matter into some areas; almost pure sand to help hold the Bermuda, mostly on the collars.

In the early part of this year, we had eight weeks of hot, dry, 20-mile-an-hour winds. I continued to saturate my bunkers and greens, using 1½ quarts of wetting agent in 200 gallons of water, if they showed signs of dryness. My soil kept loose and the water would penetrate without running off. (In a wet period it keeps the water moving through.) I've applied my wetting agent, Aqua-gro, when the temperature was 35° or 95° without experiencing any burn.

Our fairways are fertilized three times a year at approximately 800 lbs/acre, 40 per cent being organic. During the winter months we use a liquid fertilizer on the greens approximately every two weeks. We include the wetting agent to give more uniform color, and when the color goes out there is no splotch.

Wetting agents

In summer, the temperature averages around 85°. Every time the spray tank goes out on the course, we put 1½ quarts of wetting agent in it. This gives me better control and gets the fungicide down to the roots. (The topdressing is a sterilized mix of 70 per cent sand and 30 per cent heavy muck or marle).

To give you an example of the real extreme weather we sometimes experience, this past February we had a complete white frost with temperatures in the 30°-31° range. (In general, it was a cool month with very heavy dews.) However, knowing the frost was coming, I saturated the greens with a wetting agent because our Bermuda grass, especially 328, has a tendency to turn black. I boosted my application rate to 2½ quarts in 200 gallons of water (for approximately 25,000 sq. ft.). The day after there was no frost on the bunkers or greens—and the golfers were able to start right off! □

happiness on a golf course or in the clubhouse, but a thorough study is necessary—and urgent. Just as a reminder of how this essential is neglected, notice at your club in the men's locker-room how there are many items of male beauty treatments, but for a first aid kit, a package of adhesive bandages is about all that's around.

An adequate first aid outfit ought to be a "must" in every lockerroom for men and women. In addition, each lockerroom should have a list, prominently displayed, of addresses and telephone numbers of available doctors, nearest hospital, ambulance service and some golfing physicians' advice. An oxygen tank supply should also be on hand.

men and their working conditions. (But, again, here's a place for the safety committee's work. It's safest to check over every detail on inspection tours with the superintendent.)
20. In the clubhouse major causes of accidents are: people in spikes slipping on concrete floors or steps; bare feet slipping on wet floors of bath departments or spikes catching in worn carpeting. (Sanitation to prevent athlete's foot is standard practice now at any good private club or public or fee course.)

When the accidents happen, maybe those who were hurt won't injure or kill any of these fellows who could have prevented these casualties from ever occurring. □

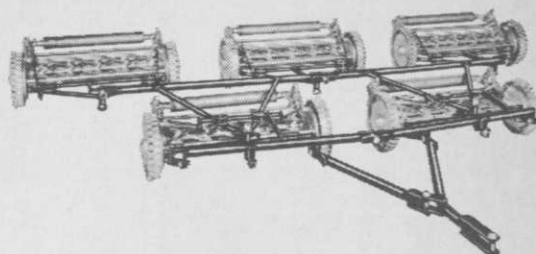

70.188 average for 85 official tournament rounds, is a solid indication that the spectacular Arnie isn't over the hill. Hogan won the Radix award five times from 1940 through 1948 . . . Palmer's first win was in 1961. Radix was the greatest pro golf fan we ever knew. (His award is similar to the Vardon trophy of the PGA.) Radix spent more money making long distance telephone calls, and having his secretary spend time looking for jobs for pros, than any other golf amateur.

Again, I've got to say Golf Course Superintendent Reporter edited by Charles Calhoun for Iowa GCSA, does a marvelous job of getting into superintendents' heads stories such as those on Herb Klotz, Ted Smith, Norm Westfall and others. It makes you think you're reading biographies of dedicated artists. □
