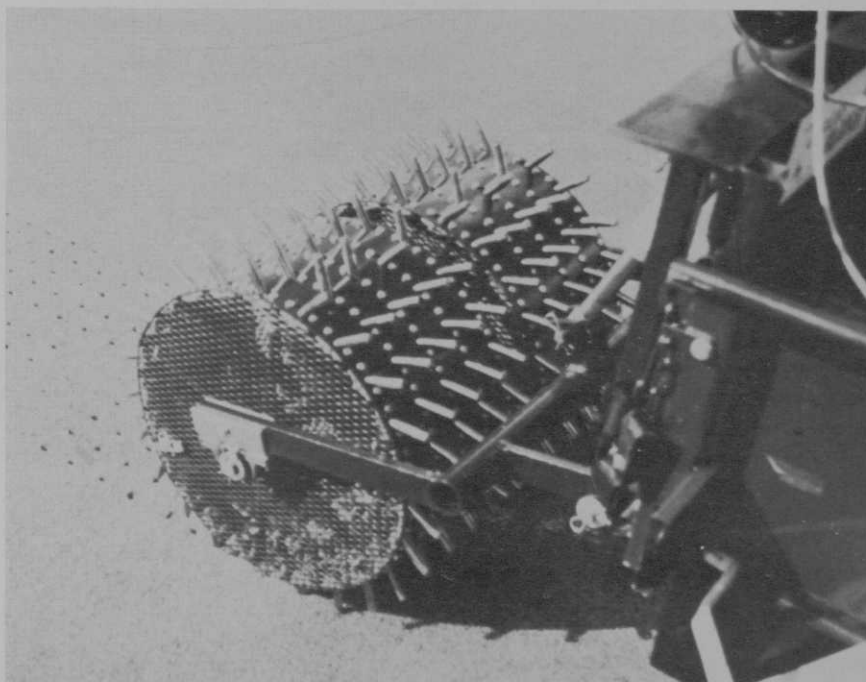

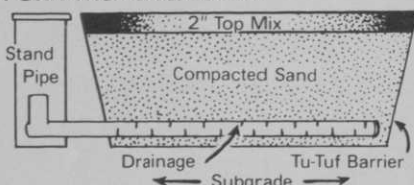

PURR-Wick Cross Section



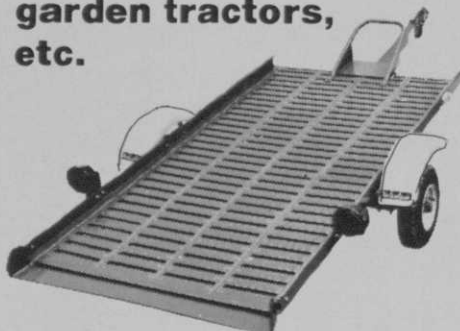
