The 82.5 percent spray-dried chlorothalonil fungicide readily disperses and resuspends in the spray tank. Echo Ultimate should be applied prior to snow cover to prevent gray snow mold, with repeat treatments at monthly intervals if snow is intermittent or lacking.
