A PRAYER for those growing old

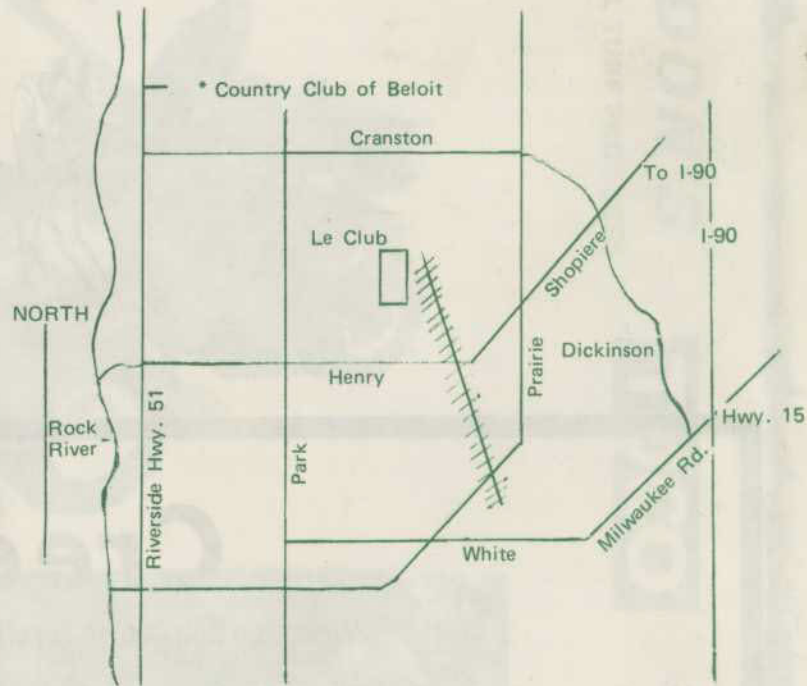
