
THE WGCSA DONATES \$4,000 TO TURFGRASS RESEARCH IN WISCONSIN

The membership of the Wisconsin Golf Course Superintendents Association voted unanimously to donate \$4,000 to the Wisconsin Turfgrass Association for 1985. The gift was made at the March membership meeting in Fond du Lac and was accepted by WGCSA member Tom Harrison, President of the Wisconsin Turfgrass Association.

This action moves the WGCSA into its proper role as the major contributor and supporter of turf-grass research at our land grant college in Madison. The generosity of the grant to the WTA sets the stage for what Harrison feels will be a very strong year for the WTA. He also expressed confidence that this donation may inspire other related turf groups in Wisconsin to expand and increase their level of support.
