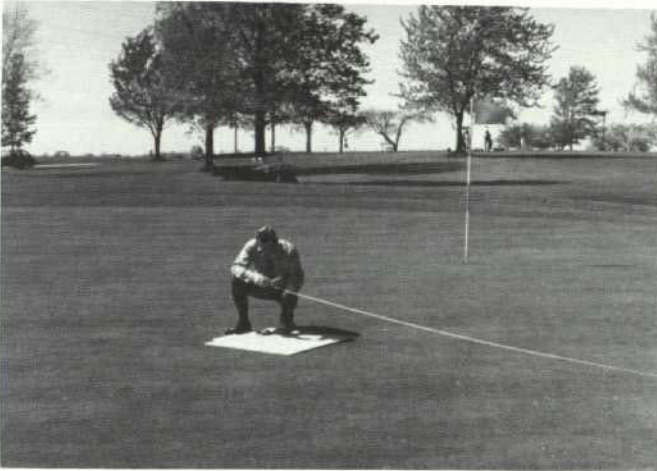


A BOB WELCH PHOTO ALBUM
