Rick played professional softball for 20 years from 1979 - 1998. He played as a pitcher turning pro after playing his college baseball at UW- Oshkosh. His professional softball experience led him all across the United States playing for various teams. His softball resume is as follows:

- 1979-1982: Rick played with the professional team in Milwaukee-The Milwaukee Schlitz. The team played in the World Series of Softball in 1979. ESPN's very first broadcast began in 1979 by televising this World Series game. That year Rick was the MVP of the World Series and league MVP along with batting champion.
- 1983- 1990: Rick played for the Steel Sports Company based in Cleveland, Ohio. He also represented the company with his own insignia bats along with balls and gloves. Rick traveled the country playing and promoting the products.
- 1991-1998: Rick played for Riche's Superior based out of Windsor Locks, Ct. The team was sponsored by Louisville Sluggers. During this time Rick played in 49 out of 50 states in the United States. He also promoted his own line of bats.
