On August 15th 2011 a joint meeting was held with WGCSA and Northern Great Lakes Golf Course Superintendents Association Members attending.

Host Superintendent Scott Sann and his staff had the course in wonderful condition for our group.

Greenwood Hills Country Club was incorporated in Wausau in 1989 and construction began in 1991. As with many projects with open soil record rains came in 1992 and spring of 1993 causing numerous setbacks and delays in course construction. The front 9 was able to open in fall of 1993 while the back 9 was available for play in August of 1994.

The modern clubhouse opened in 1995 to provide a full service facility for the membership. Scott and his staff provide wintertime recreation for the members with groomed cross-country skiing and snowshoe hiking trails.

In June of 2000 Sann let Greenwood Hills to designation as a Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary. At the time
