March 21, but the earlier that you get your donation in, the better that we're all able to hype the auction to potential bidders.

Once again, we are hoping that Steve Stricker will agree to be the face of the auction. I think that it's a testament to the WGC-SA and to the cause that PAR 4 supports that one of the most successful and recognizable golfers in the world has supported our efforts. Personally, when promoting the auction to Blackhawk's members, I was proud to note the affiliation between our organization and Mr. Stricker.

Certainly, the PAR 4 committee recognizes that not all clubs are able to donate due to policies that are outside of our control, but if that isn't the case, ask your decision makers to consider
