Not only can you get a great deal of help and information from an exchange like this, but you can contribute solutions to other people's problems based on your experience.

Compendium of Turfgrass Diseases Now Available

Serious students of turfgrass will welcome this new addition to the literature pertaining to turf health that has been made available to use. It is a 102 page compilation that does an excellent job of laying out the descriptions and disease cycles, along with some epidemiology and control information on over 50 pathogenic diseases and several additional non-pathogenic diseases and several additional non-pathogenic disorders. It was prepared by Dr. Richard Smiley, Cornell University for publication by the parent society of plant pathologists — The American Phytopathological Society. The publication is not easy bed-time reading! But golf course superintendents who have been studying turf for awhile will not be overwhelmed by it, and will likely welcome the book as an addition to their professional library. There are nearly 200 color-illustrations and many 100 black and white photographs to accompany the written word.

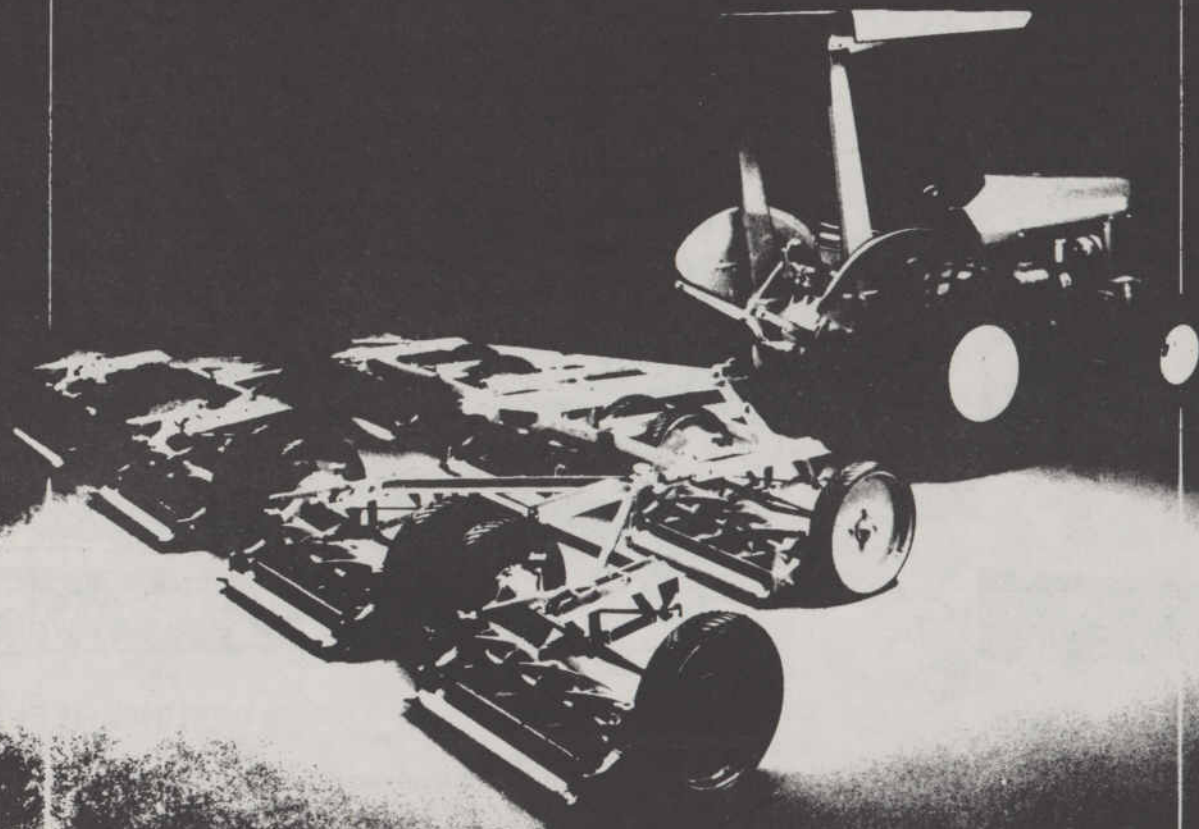
