FROM SOIL FERTILITY NOTES, a University of Minnesota publication, comes the following quotation of a study of Nitrogen fertilization of turf by Dr. Rouse Farnham.

"Description: A total of 32 combinations of materials and rates are compared on a bluegrass turf. Of particular interest is the performance of recently developed slow release N fertilizers. Study carried out over past 3 years.

Summary: Several of the new fertilizers will adequately supply N for whole season with one application. These slow release forms will give a very uniform pattern of growth throughout the season. Urea formaldehyde types appear to release N too slowly in this climate.
