## Host Association Booth - Jim Lindblad

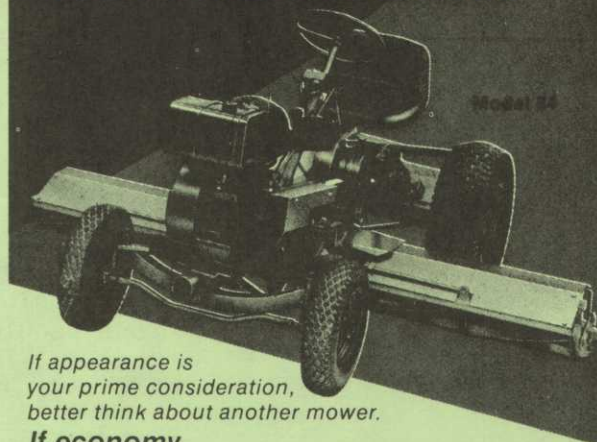

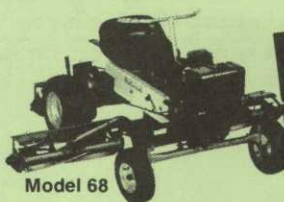

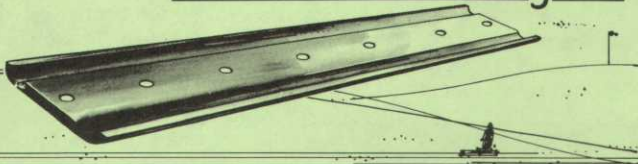
