I personally believe that the Minnesota Golf Course Superintendents will be benefitted by this decision and that our efforts in this case were not without results. The phrase "for the control on fungi of the snow mold complex" is, I believe, of Minnesota origin. And lastly, I believe the Judge is to be commended for reminding us and the Environmental Protection Agency that "Environmental Problems should be parsed with a scalpel not a hacksaw".

The EPA and Freers Company have raised exceptions to the above Mercury cancellation decision. The final decision may not be the one referred to above pending the outcome of these exceptions.
