

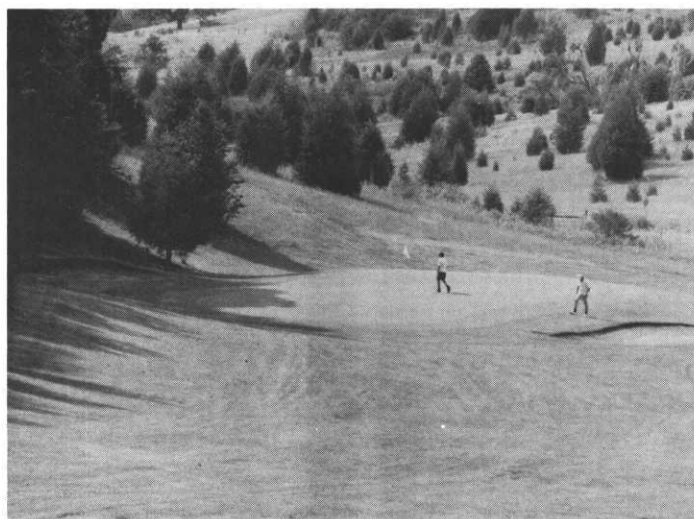
THE HUDSON HUSTLE

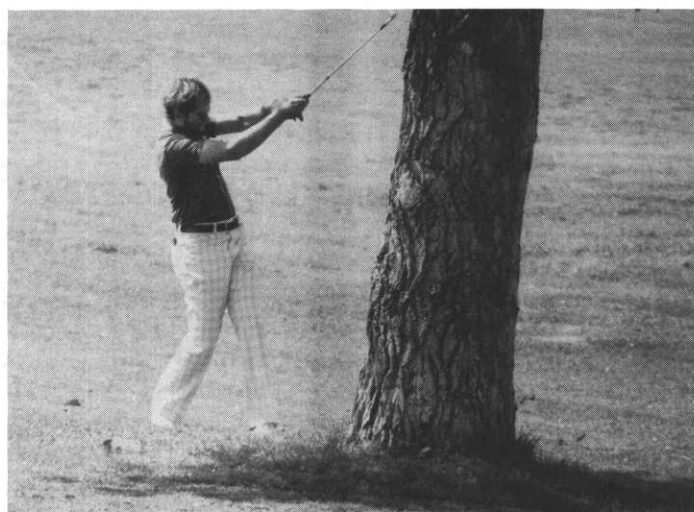
