Thank you for your time, have a safe holiday season. I'll see you at the MTGF Turf Conference & Show in early December. Until next month. —Rob Panuska Editor

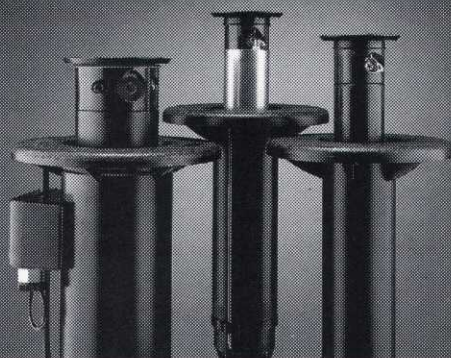
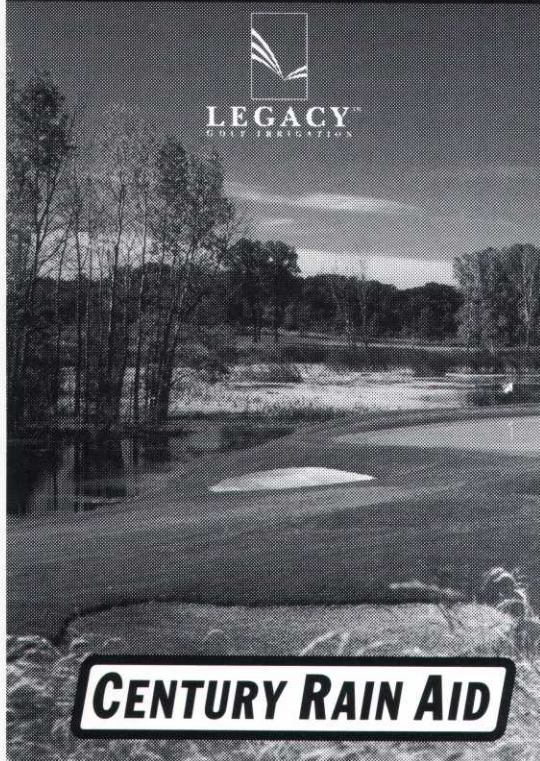
