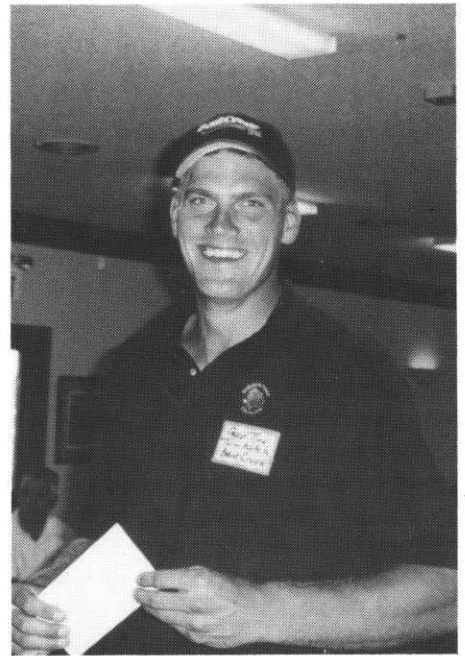


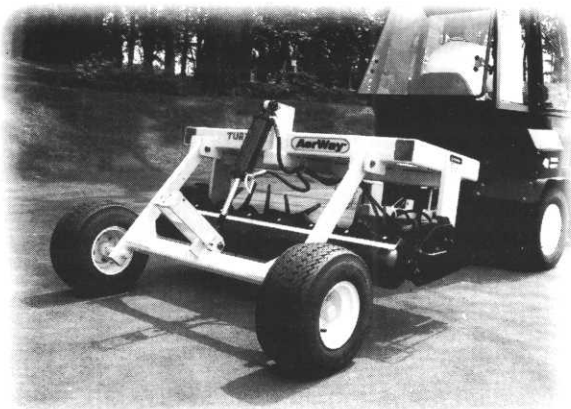

Tom Keintzle's Legacy Team Advances To 1999 Oldsmobile Finals

Tom Keintzle, golf course superintendent at Cragun's and the Brainerd resort's five person Legacy golf team, is headed to the Oldsmobile Scramble national finals in Orlando, Fla. October 7-8-9.

They recently won the sectional at The Pines in Nisswa. If they make the cut in Orlando, they will play with a touring pro on October 11.

The team from Cragun's consists of the following: Chuck Klekatsky, Tom Keintzle, Steve Stoxen, Dan Steiger and Mary Hasselberg.

They shot a scramble 58 and had a team handicap of three, giving them a net 55. This won low net honors in the field of 27 teams.

The other finals qualifier at The Pines was a team from New Richmond, WI, with a gross scramble score of 57, best of the day.

Highlight over the years for Orlando/Minnesota teams was in 1993, when a team from Grand View Lodge finished fourth in the low net competition for the entire country. Tom Keintzle and Steve Stoxen were on the 1993 team, so it's a return to Orlando for them.
