Team from Cloquet Country Club and HydroLogic Wins 2000 Stodola at Alexandria Golf Club

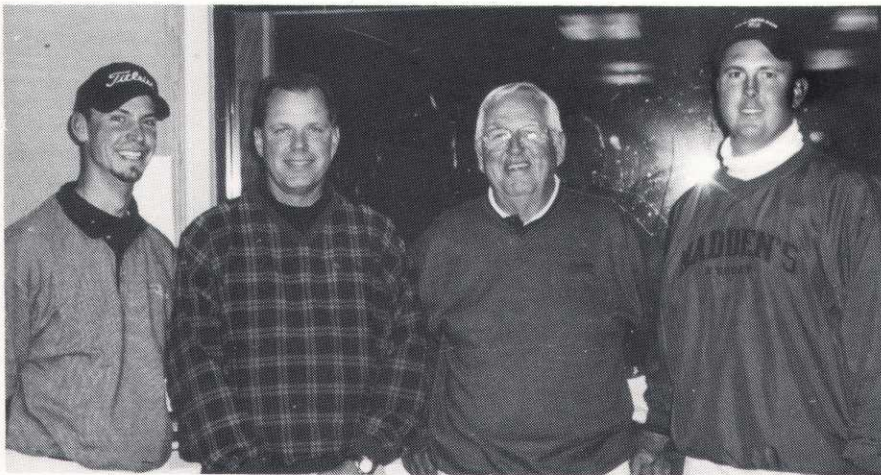
