

Dean Wojtczak Wins MGCSA Championship at Minikahda

On behalf of the Minnesota Golf Course Superintendents' Association we would like to extend our thanks and appreciation to The Minikahda Club for hosting our Championship on September 8. The support from the club and the prime condition of the course made for a spectacular day to celebrate golf.

Dean Wojtczak, Whispering Pines Golf Club, was able to handle the 11.5 green speed in route to a score of 80 to win the 2008 MGCSA Championship. Three time Champion Jeff Pint, New Prague Golf Club, finished second one shot behind. Mike Kelly, Bayer Environmental Science, finished third shooting an 82.

Larry Gorman, Green Image, won the First Flight with a net score of 69. Brian Horgan, University of Minnesota, finished with a net 70. Ben Just, Midland Hills Country Club, came in third with a net 72.

Home course Superintendent Jeff Johnson won the second flight shooting a net 75. Kyle Stern, Minnesota Valley Country Club, finished second with a net 77.

This year's Senior Champion is Jim O'Neill, Cycle Works of Minnesota. Jim shot a net 74. Jerry Webb, Riverwood National, came in second with a net 75.

Winning a scorecard playoff for the Callaway Flight was Brian Grill, Interlachen Country Club, edging out co-workers Brian Boll and Rick (Auto) Carr, all shooting a net 73.

Our 2008 Long Drive champion is Ryan Popp, John Deere Golf. Jim O'Neill, Cycle Works, sank the longest putt of the day on number 15. The four winners of the closest to the pin competition were Donnacha O'Connor, Alexandria Golf Club; Jeff Johnson, The Minikahda Club; Mike Redmond, MTI Distributing Co., and Larry Gorman, GreenImage LLC.

Host Superintendent Jeff Johnson and his staff had the course in mint condition and the greens rolling over 11 on the stimp meter. Catering Director Nicole Fitzgerald and her staff were very helpful in pre-tournament preparations. Host Golf Professional Doug Nelson and his staff helped in the scoring the event which had members anxiously waiting the results.

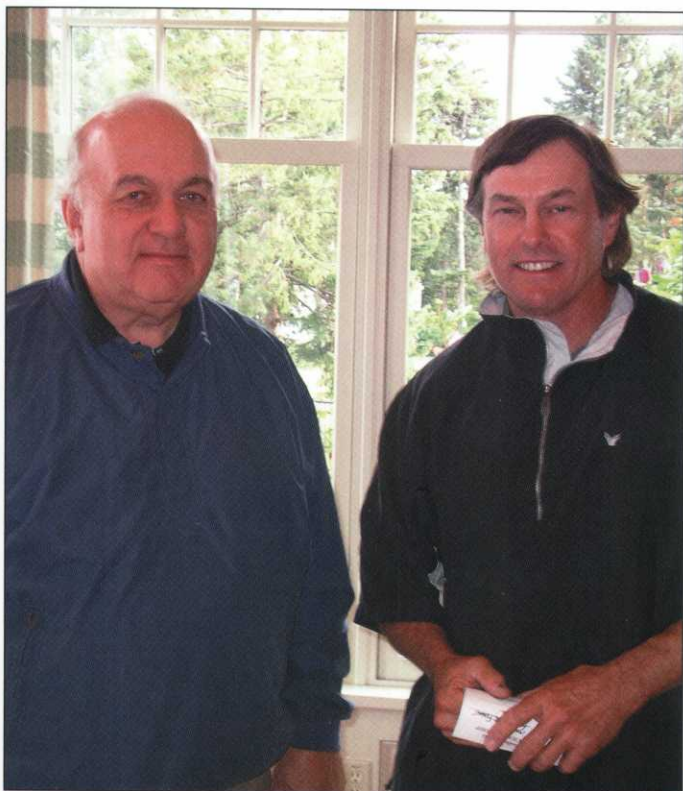
