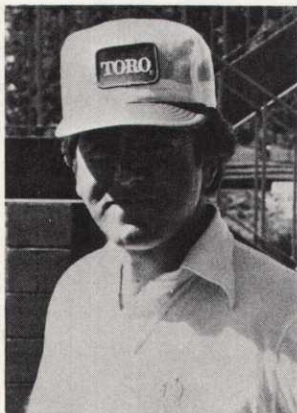


MEET YOUR SUPERINTENDENTS !
