An article in the BALTIMORE SUN, 3/2/79, is of related interest to us all: Effective March 1, 1979 the Environmental Protection Agency has put emergency bans on two widely used herbicides that contain dioxin (2, 4, 5, T). Additionally, the ban effects "Silvex" a chemical related to 2, 4, 5, T. Silvex is marketed under a variety of names like Weed-B-Gone, Ded'weed, Silvi-Rhap, and Fruitone. This ban is not permanent: DOW Chemical, the primary producers of 2, 4, 5, T, questions the validity of the Oregon study cited by the EPA. Presently it is not known if this ban will become permanent or lifted in the future.
