The tees are a combination Bluegrass, Ryegrass and Bermuda and are cut at 3/4 inch. The fairways are a mixture of Bluegrass and Bermuda and are overseeded with Ryegrass. They are also cut at 3/4 inch.

From Eastern Shore take Route 50 to 450.

Follow 450 to light, turn left. Keep right to the light. For golf go straight to the course. For dinner and meeting keep right to the Guard House. Tell the guard that you would like to go to the EM club (Enlisted Mess Open) which is the first left past the guard house.
