### Penn State student receives first annual scholarship

The Golf Course Superintendents Association of America (GCSAA) has named **Katelyn Ritter** of Mount Airy, Md., as the first recipient of the Joseph S. Garske Collegiate Grant.

The \$2,500 grant, funded by Par Aide and administered through The Environmental Institute for Golf, was established in honor of Par Aide company founder Joseph S. Garske. The grant is renewable for a second year with proof of enrollment and a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

#### **GCSAA Legacy Awards**




