

Late years have seen a very notable increase in the use of cast iron pipe for golf course irrigation systems. That this has not come about sooner has been, perhaps more the fault of the pipe makers than of the golf course architects. The latter were quite ready to use pipe of so permanent a nature as cast iron, but consideration of cost, the employment of skilled joint makers, and the dearth of small diameter cast iron pipe placed them at a disadvantage in attempting to do so.

The McWane Cast Iron Pipe Company, with foundries in Birmingham, Ala., and Provo, Utah, however, has of late been putting a different face upon this situation. and the golf architects have given their new departure a very cordial reception.

The contribution of the McWane Company has been to bring out commercially a cast iron pipe as small as 11/4 and 2 inches in diameter at prices as low or lower than galvanized wrought pipe in many instances. This took care of the fact that a very large amount of the

pipe footage in a golf course watering system was in these new sizes for cast iron pipe, hitherto too small for it to be available by former casting methods.

Another difficulty in cast iron pipe was the joints. They required yarning" the joints, pouring them full of molten lead on the job, and, finally, calking each joint by hand. With very small cast iron pipe coming in 5 and 6-foot lengths, this made a prohibitive amount of labor in the field using it.

The McWane company, however, brought out at the same time its "precalked" joint, which is a factory-made joint of the bell and spigot type, in which the lead, jute, etc., and a self-tightening feature were all delivered in place in the pipe bells, thus reducing pipe laying with

it to a matter of socketing the lengths and calking. This made laying speeds, also the cost, the same for cast iron as for wrought pipe, with screw joints.

A final improvement was the introduction of the threaded intermediate joint, by means of which cast iron pipe in small diameters could be delivered in 18-foot laying lengths, with a field joint to be calked only at these longer intervals.
