


Cleveland Winter Program

during the coming year. It was decided to postpone appointing this committee until the December 5 meeting.

It was moved and seconded that meetings this winter be held every two weeks, and that members deliver papers on special subjects. Also that the secretary, Frank Ermer, make arrangements with at least four scientists, to address the December, January, February and March alternate meetings. Mr. Ermer reported that Wendell P. Miller, drainage expert, has already consented to address the December 5 meeting.

A report of the November 2 meeting at Detroit was made by Mrs. Farley, and the members of the Cleveland Association asked Mrs. Farley to print a message in the NATIONAL GREENKEEPER addressed to the Detroit Association assuring them that Cleveland will turn out in full force at the annual convention. General discussion followed, and an invitation from W. I. Kennedy, a new member in charge of the Bunker Hill Golf Club at Medina, to hold a meeting at his club in June, 1928 was accepted with enthusiasm. It was also decided that the Association will hold the May, 1928, meeting at Braeburn Country Club, Copley, Ohio, at the invitation of L. M. Latta, who owns and operates this course.





is almost certain to attend the use of substituted materials, although somewhat less nitrogen is frequently effective because of the greater availability of the nitrogen in other materials.

In order to obtain uniform distribution, so essential to success a good fertilizer distributor should be used. Either the two-wheel lime and fertilizer spreader or the end-gate type lime spreader is effective. With the former type machine phosphate and nitrogenous materials can be mixed right in the hopper. The necessity of uniform applications is not generally appreciated. Fertilizers should be applied prior to the last discing so they can be worked into the soil.
