


KIRTLAND GOLFERS RIDE TO 18TH TEE


Probably the most unique installation in the history of golf course maintenance is the electrically operated cable car which was installed this spring at the Kirtland Country Club, Willoughby, O. The 17th green at Kirtland is in a valley and the 18th tee on top of a hill. It was a long tiresome and sometimes dangerous climb for the older members at the finish of their round of golf. So Mr. Walter L. Robison of the Green committee conceived the plan of the automatic car lift which you see pictured herewith.

The driving equipment consists of a 35 H. P. Westinghouse, elevator type, two speed motor with push button control. The hoist is of the Lidgerwood double reduction cylindrical drum type designed for a car speed of approximately 200 ft. per minute. The length of the incline is about 250 ft. equivalent to a lift of 75 feet. The entire installation is enclosed with 650 ft. of Page Chain Link fence style 3TR 7' high overall, installed by the Betz-Pierce Co. of Cleveland, O. Upper photo shows the 17th green.

The Put-in-Bay course is twenty-five hundred and thirty-eight yards long and overlooks the scene of Perry's Victory in 1813. In fact the first tee is almost in the shadow of the world's famed Perry's monument whose mammoth granite column is a landmark for yachtsmen who traverse the western end of Lake Erie.

The greenkeeper at Put-in-Bay is Alex Miller, formerly in charge of the Adolph Zukor Estate, near New York City. Miller is a ember of the N. A. G. A. and began his greenkeeping career at the Dover Bay Country Club near Cleveland.



(Continued from page 17) same as that of last Fall. Cable crop reports as well as cable quotations from the principal producers of Europe on Red, Sheeps and Hard Fescue lead us to expect a normal crop but one slightly delayed on account of the heavy winter and cool Spring. The prices for European fescues will probably remain the same as have existed during the past two years.

Better Drainage

Fall is the time to put in the drainage you needed so badly this The heavy rainfall this season. spring caused washouts, which could only be repaired at heavy expense.


