MORE LABS WILL PROVIDE TESTING

Several Ontrio laboratories will be providing analyses under the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food's new laboratory accreditation program which came into effect September 1, 1989.

In March, the ministry announced its intentions to further privatize laboratory testing services for farms, home lawn and garden greenhouse media, plant tissues and livestock feeds. Ontario-based laboratories were invited to provide the testing services.

Until five years ago, the ministry's laboratory testing ser-

vices were handled by the University of Guelph. At that time, the ministry tendered for testing services and one laboratory was given a five year contract which expired August 31, 1989.

Clients will be required to pay for all analyses. To date, they were not paying analyses of farm soils.

The following laboratories have been accredited to provide the services note. Other laboratories are in the process of submitting their results and refining their procedures. Additional laboratories may be accredited and announced later this fall.

Submission forms are available in English and French from your local OMAF office with a comprehensive listing of all accredited labs, analyses offered and details on how to submit samples.
