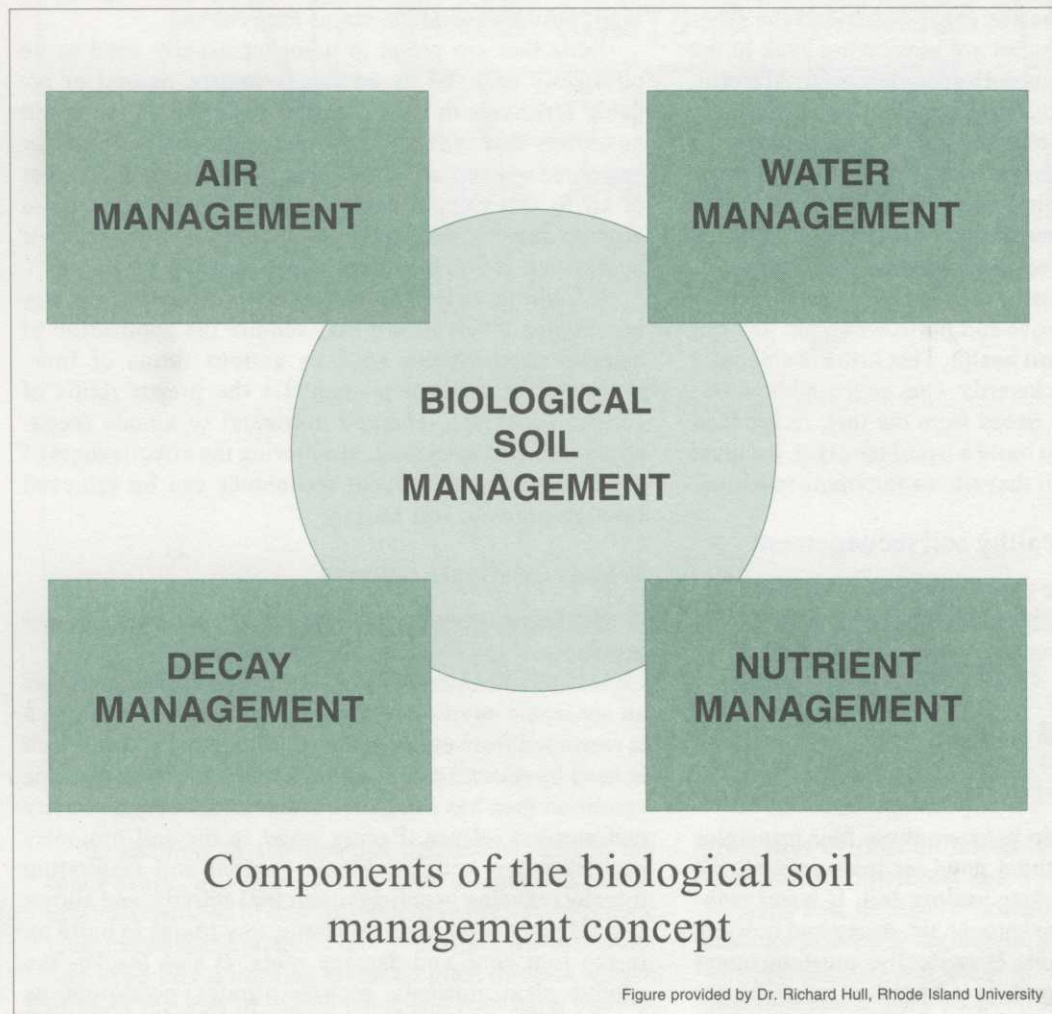
## Biological soil management
