

EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES - March 4-9, 1973, Asilomar Conference Grounds,
Pacific Grove, California

The 1973 California Golf Course Superintendents' Institute is the first, in a series of five symposiums which focus on all phases of professional golf course management. Designed specifically for golf course superintendents, this first institute covers soils, water, grass, and climate, and their application to the California golf course. Emphasis will be placed on basic principles of turfgrass management and on problem analysis techniques which can be applied to individual courses.

Dr. John Madison, professor of environmental horticulture, University of California, Davis, is the program director. He will be assisted by William B. Davis, Agriculture Extension environmental horticulturist. Through lectures, discussion groups, and case studies, University and Agriculture Extension faculty will present ideas, concepts, and solutions. All members of the Institute will be required to actively participate in discussion periods.

University of California Davis Extension credit and a certificate of completion are available to those successfully completing the Institute. Tuition fee of \$225 covers instruction, study materials, a copy of the proceedings, meals, and lodging. The program begins at 4:00 p.m. March 4th and ends at 12:00 noon on March 9th. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Enrollment is limited to golf course superintendents, and a maximum of seventy participants will be accepted.
