Basically if you missed this years event you missed a good day, with some good people on a great golf course.

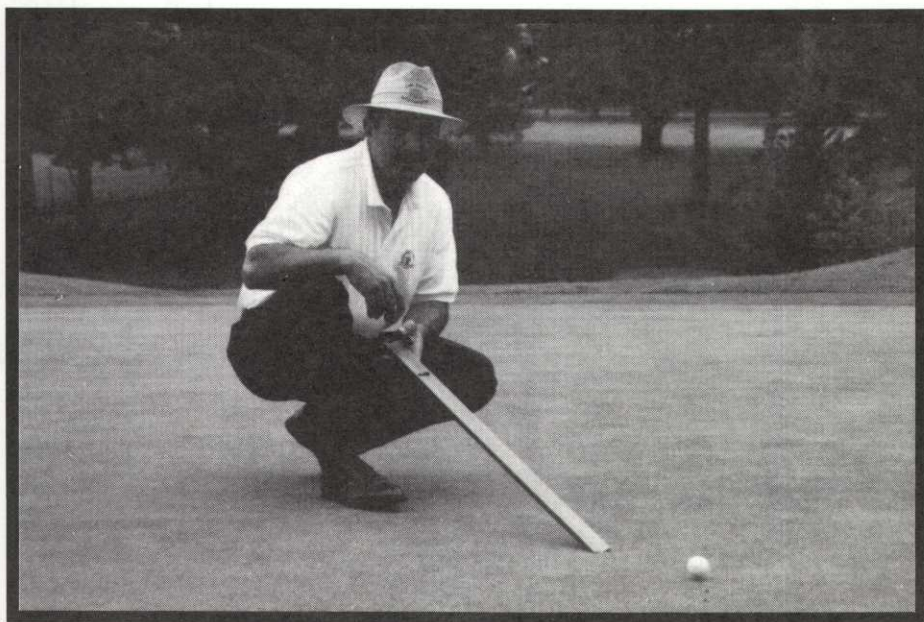
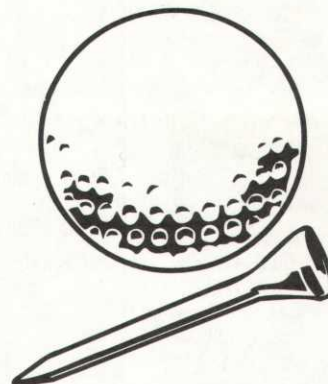
