
PALO ALTO HILLS GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB by Tim Sedgley
Palo Alto Hills Golf & CC is a private club located in the foothills of
Palo Alto. The course was opened for play in 1960 after being developed
by Ken Venturi. There are approximately 350 golfing members and 100
social members. The course is 6,400 yards long and the par is 71.
The course is very hilly and tree lined. The total area is 130 acres;
80 of which are in turf, There are 10 men on the crew responsible for
the golf course, clubhouse grounds, and indoor plants.

TIM SEDGLEY started work in the profession in 1970 at Green Gables CC in Denver, Colorado as a night waterman. He worked at Cherry Hills CC in Denver from 1971-1974 while attending Colorado State University. He graduated in 1974 with a B.S. in Landscape Horticulture. Following graduation, he was the Assistant Superintendent at Mesa Verde CC (1975-1976) in Southern California and Cherry Hills CC (1977-1978)

In 1978 he became the Superintendent at the Old Baldy Club in Wyoming until December of 1979 when he moved to Palo Alto Hills. During the last two years, the club has installed a complete irrigation system, rebuilt 3 holes, and renovated all of the fairways. Other projects included the planting of over 300 trees and shrubs.

The biggest problem with the course now is poor drainage with a tight soil and a great deal of seepage from surrounding hills.

Tim has been a past member of the Rocky Mountain GCSA and the Southern California GCSA and is a Class A member of GCSA of America. Tim and his wife, Martha, reside in Mountain View. His hobbies include golf, racquet-ball, photography, and horticulture.

A TRIBUTE TO DAVE MASTROLEO by Clifford A. Wagoner, Modesto

Dave Mastroleo retired as editor of the Divot News and the new editor is Mike Heacock. In Mike's first issue he made the following statement which almost says it all "Dave never missed an issue in almost 21 years at the grindstone. The job Dave did is remarkable, and the thanks he generally received for it is also remarkable—primarily by its absence. Dave has put more of his own time, money, effort and love into this Assocaition than any other man living or dead". The Divot News is the GCSA of Southern California Chapter newsletter.

Dave gave his time freely to the state and nationa associations. He was one of the founders of the California Federation. Prior to that Dave was instrumental in organization of the north-south superintendents joint meeting which were held at San Luis Obispo and Santa Maria. Although these were only social meetings a great deal of comradeship developed. In the early days of the Federation, Dave offered the "Divot News" as a California paper. His offer had no takers. If the new concepts of a California organization accepted a California newsletter may become a reality. We are very fortunate to Dave and Donna as friends and coworkers to promote not only the organization but also the profession.
