

STEVE CARLTON, CGCS - Steve started his golf course career as a greenskeeper at Pebble Beach Golf Links in 1971. He became Assistant Superintendent at Almaden Golf and CC in 1973 and got his first Superintendent's job at Carmel Valley Golf and CC in 1974. Since then he has worked at Pomona National GC and Los Coyotes CC in Southern California, and did golf course construction work at Carmel Valley Ranch and La Quinta Hotel GC. He was the Superintendent at San Jose CC for five years before moving on to Gilroy GC.

Built in 1922, Gilroy Golf and CC was originally a semiprivate club. Since January of this year, the city of Gilroy took over operation of the Golf Course, as it is on City owned land.


