With burglaries and vandalism on the increase, the publishers of WEEDS TREES & TURF have launched a program to make information available on a new security lock.


The front knob of the lock contains an exclusive slip clutch that adds to the pick-proof features. Intruders can't twist the knob off to gain entry to homes, machine sheds and storage areas. Each lock has an automatic dead locking plunger to prevent entry with a plastic card or thin knife.

The lock opens by dialing a correct sequence of four numbers,

much like a telephone. Once closed, the door is secure and can't be reopened without dialing the exact combination again . . . unless the inside bypass has been activated.
