

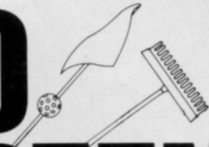

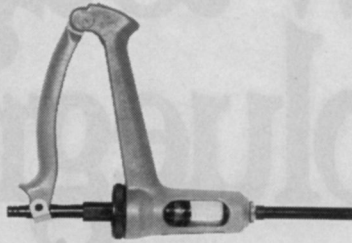

## Compact core aerator is self-propelled

The Powerplug is F.D. Kees' new core aerator. Compact and easy to transport, it is powered by a 5 hp Briggs & Stratton I/C engine with crankshaft style aerating mechanism.

The self-propelled unit covers more than one-third acre per hour, its replaceable stainless steel tines producing a 16-inch pattern. A single lever adjusts the penetration depth from one-half to two inches.

Other features include a 6:1 gear reducer, handle-mounted throttle, fold-over handle and a three-quarter fuel tank.

## With this fish snacking, weeds are sent packing

The white amur, a small fish native to China, controls underwater vegetation, eating weeds, moss, algae, grasses and all submergent weeds.

The fish can only be bred in conditions simulating hatching conditions in China's Amur River. The fish, while it won't reproduce outside of those specific conditions, has a lifespan of 12 to 15 years, controlling vegetation throughout.

It has been tested in the United States since 1958 in agricultural and

industrial waters, golf course ponds, municipal water supplies and lakes.
