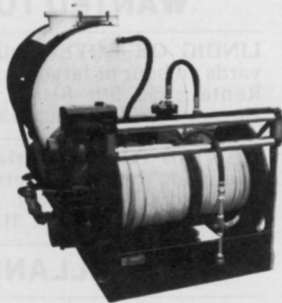

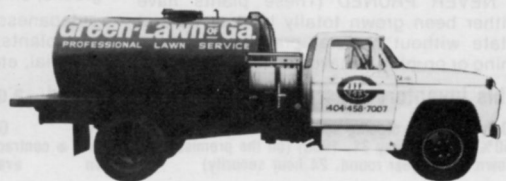

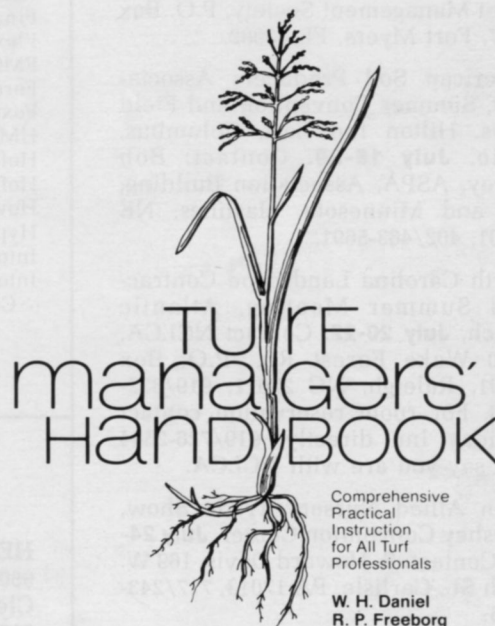
Finally, An Aid For Teaching Turfgrass
