Biographical/Historical

Reidar Haugen was a cellist, composer and arranger with careers in Chicago, Illinois, and Lansing, Michigan. Reidar Haugan is not known to have been affiliated with Michigan State University. He was active in Local 303, American Federation of Musicians, and played with many chamber music and dance orchestras in mid-Michigan. His name appears frequently in notices of concerts and performances in the Lansing State Journal. He died Wednesday, June 10, 1964; no age or birthdate is given in his obituary. He was also a Michigan State Highway Department employee.

Scope and Content

The Reidar Haugan collection contains original compositions by Haugan as well as arrangements. Unless otherwise noted, music is in Haugan's hand, in black ink. Most words with the letter "u" follow the Germanic custom of a curved or straight line above the letter.
