Historical Note

The Ann Arbor Railroad Technical and Historical Association is a non-profit Michigan organization whose stated purpose is to collect, preserve and disseminate information and artifacts concerning the history of the Ann Arbor Railroad. The *News Letter*, which is published about five times a year, is the vehicle through which much of this activity is reported. Prior to 1982, the Association was named the Ann Arbor Railroad Historical Society. Its newsletter was called *The Ann Arbor by Rail and Lake* and was first published in 1978. When the Historical Society changed its name in 1982, it renamed its publication the *News Letter*, and in 1985 changed again to *The Double A*.
