The Meridian Board of Trustees appointed 22 township residents as members of the committee. Their task was to conduct studies and research and make a report on the historical significance of the buildings, structures, features, sites, objects and surroundings in Meridian Township and to make recommendations concerning the area to be included in a proposed historic district.
