Linda Millette was a student at Michigan State University from 1958-1962. She came as a home economics major but switched to social sciences studying sociology, psychology, and comparative religion. She joined the Peace Corps in 1962 and spent 3 years in Malawi teaching. She received her B.A. in 1965.

This Linda Millette collection contains many items pertaining to student life at Michigan State University (MSU) from 1958-1965. The collection includes MSU student identification cards,

Also included is a photocopy of a 1899 Michigan Common School Diploma for Vina Doty, a relative of Linda Millette.
