## Historical Note

---

The Clinical Center is the first Michigan State University structure devoted to human health and medical care. Initial planning for this building began in 1967 but a lack of federal funding in 1970 stalled the plans moving forward. In 1972, the College of Osteopathic Medicine joined the College of Human Medicine on the campus and the need for a patient-oriented facility became obvious. Federal funding was available so planning began anew. Construction contracts were awarded at the end of 1973 and ground breaking occurred in January 1974. Building construction was completed in 1976.
