There is also a photo of Ray and Alwynelle at the beach wearing MSU green and white wool jackets. The clothing was a gift from their uncle, MSU professor Alvin Parker. The photos contain captions on the back describing the colors and there is also a note from the donor describing the clothing as well as contains biographical information.
