## **Biographical Note**

Ellen Norris Mathews was born December 26, 1907 in Mississippi. She married Davis Lyen Mathews (December 16, 1912 - March 4, 1974) in 1937. Davis L. Mathews served in the U.S. Army during World War II and the Korean War. From circa 1955 to circa 1970, Ellen Mathews worked in the Department of Military Science at Michigan State University. After leaving East Lansing, the Mathews moved to California. Ellen Mathews died on May 7, 1993.
