## **Historical Note**

Michigan State University Track can trace its roots to the intercollegiate field day competitions held during the 1880s. In 1888, Michigan Agricultural College (M.A.C.), as MSU was then known, became a member of the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association where it dominated the annual field day events winning 15 championships in 20 years. A student assumed the duties of track coach in 1898; the following year a non-student coach was hired. In 1908, M.A.C. competed in the Big Ten Track Championships in certain events and continued to compete against Big Ten institutions after joining the conference in 1950.
